

## **GUIDELINES TO CLUBS REGARDING TRIBUNAL**

### **Additional Witnesses**

1. The persons who are eligible to be called as witness must be nominated on Club Team Sheet.
2. Either party to the charge who wish to present additional witnesses at a hearing must give the AFL Brisbane Juniors 24 hours notice of their intentions to call such witnesses, with their names, a maximum of three additional witnesses may be called AND MUST BE NOMINATED ON THE CLUB TEAM SHEET

### **Video Evidence:**

Video Evidence submitted by Clubs must be made available to the AFL Brisbane Juniors 24 hours prior to the hearing

Video evidence may be submitted from any of:

- Television station coverage of incident
- Club video coverage of incident, or
- AFL Brisbane Juniors video coverage of incident

Tribunal Chairperson informs of video evidence after hearing the reported player's plea

All verbal evidence will be heard before the video is played

All Tribunal members, the accused player and advocate, the umpire and advocate, and the witness and advocate, will gather around the video monitor and the incident will be played.

- at normal speed
- at slow motion
- and again at normal speed

Tribunal members will notify all concerned that this will be the only time during the hearing that video evidence will be viewed by all attending Tribunal

The Tribunal members may further consult the video of the incident whilst determining the report
