

# Rule Changes

## Team Sizes –page 38

If a match starts with 18 a side or 16 a side and an injury occurs or any send off's, the match remains at number of players that the match started with. Further more if a team has less than 14 players on the playing surface at any one time the game shall continue.

## The Hearing –page 48

### **No Legal representation**

A written application must be received by the AFL BJ Manager, 48hrs prior to the Tribunal time if you want to have legal representation. The AFL Brisbane Juniors Board of Management will make all endeavors' to have legal representation for the Tribunal, Umpire and Witnesses.

## Late Start –page 28

Neither team is permitted to leave the playing surface at ¼ time or ¾ time unless permission is given by the AFL BJ – Manager, Board Member or the Umpire.

## Club Boundary Umpire –page 99

- Must be at least 12 years of age
- A maximum of 2 people per side
- To follow the instructions of the boundary umpire under the AFL guidelines
- Cannot report any players
- Must be wearing the bib

## Club Goal Umpire –page 99

- Must be at least 12 years of age
- To follow the instructions of the goal umpire under the AFL guidelines
- Cannot report any players
- Must be wearing the bib - 2007 onwards
- Both clubs are to provide one person to be a goal umpire

## Send Off – New Ruling

2 send off's for the same player in one match is an automatic report.

3 send off's for the same player in one season is an automatic one week suspension.
